N.J.A.C. 8:57-6: Higher Education Immunization Requirements

	By Age Indication	Doses
Hepatitis B **	All new college students	Three doses (Two doses between ages 11-15 may be acceptable based on vaccine product)
Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) **	All new college students	Two doses
Meningococcal (ACWY) ** <i>New</i> as of June 15, 2020	All new college students 16-18 who have no history of prior vaccination Adults 19 years of age and older and first-year college students who live in residential housing (if not previously vaccinated at age 16 or older).	One dose
Meningococcal (B) ** <i>New</i> as of June 15, 2020	All new college students 16-23 years of age at increased risk; those not at high risk may receive vaccine based on shared clinical decision making.	Two or three doses depending on vaccine and indication. Boosters as recommended.

CDC Recommended Vaccines

	By Age Indication	Doses
COVID-19 **†	All college students	One or two dose primary series, boosters as recommended
Hepatitis A **†	All college students	Two or three doses depending on vaccine
Human papillomavirus (HPV) **†	All college students through age 26 years Persons 27 through 45 may receive vaccine based on shared clinical decision making.	Two or three doses depending on age at initial vaccination or condition
Influenza **†	All college students	One dose annually
Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis (Tdap) **†	All college students	One dose for those who completed childhood DTP/DTaP; Td or Tdap booster every 10 years
Varicella (Chicken Pox) **†	All college students	Two doses are recommended at least one month apart, unless positive immune titer verifying immunity or history of disease with an approximate date presented.
